A Letter from the President

Be Prepared: Get a quick fix if you have the phone number

Do you know how to report a broken streetlight on Yale Boulevard? Do you know the RPD non-emergency number? In the age of cell phones it is easy to program seldom-used but much-needed phone numbers into your phone. Call immediately—but safely while driving—to report the issue. Broken playground equipment? Call the City's Parks and Recreation Department. Suspicious activity? Call RPD's non-emergency number or 911. Below is a list of phone numbers that I keep programmed in my cell phone to help report the commonly seen issues around the neighborhood, or to get a question answered from the City of Richardson. Many of these numbers are also printed in our neighborhood directory distributed to paid members. Don't have a cell phone? At least keep these phone numbers written down conveniently by the home phone.

By storing the above numbers in your cell phone, you can be a part of the solution of keeping our neighborhood a well-lit and beautiful place to call home.

Always dial 911 if you see activity that is suspicious or possible crime-in-progress. The Richardson Police Department always recommends immediately reporting suspicious activity to allow officers time to monitor the situation. Police respond quickly to these reports and will come "have a look around." Don't hesitate to call the police.

WHAT EVERY DUCK CREEK RESIDENT NEEDS TO KNOW

Neighborhood Integrity Program

The Neighborhood Integrity Program was created to help maintain property values and neighborhood desirability and to encourage revitalization. This takes a concerted effort from all of Duck Creek's owners and residents. By working together, we can help keep Duck Creek an attractive, healthy, and safe place to live. Over the years, minimum property maintenance standards have been established to help realize this goal.

High Grass and Weeds

Don't let your weeds or high grasses get above 12 inches on your property or in the alley behind your property.

If you do, you are in violation of the city code.

Fences

Fences should not be leaning or missing slats. If you are going to build a new fence or make significant improvements, you must apply for a building permit through the Building Inspection department at 972-744-4180.

Address Numbers

Your house numbers need to be visible from both the street and the alley. Otherwise, this could slow down an emergency response to your residence or cause confusion for the crime watch patrol volunteers.

Outside Storage

Storage items must not be visible from the front yard or the alley. You don't want to look at the junk so why should your neighbors?

Trash & Debris

Only put your trash out on the regular collection day. The City of Richardson has made it real easy for us to participate in curb side recycling by instituting the Blue Bag program.

Minimum Property Standards

Every property owner in the City of Richardson is responsible for adhering to the minimum property standards.

Vehicles

Don't park your junk or non-functioning vehicles in public view. Also, leave your semis, rigs, and 18-wheelers out of the neighborhood.

Home Occupation/Garage Sales

There are certain regulations for operating a home based business in the City of Richardson which need to be followed. No more than three garage sales per year in the City of Richardson.

Volunteer Program

If you can't maintain your property to the standards set by the City of Richardson, contact the Neigborhood Integrity program for assistance at 972-744-4166.

Yard Parking

No parking of vehicles on the side, front, or rear of the property.






Retiring Old Glory






